HANDOUT. Easter 2022 Matt 28:1-17 From Unbelief to Belief

Webster: **astonished** is defined as a:

"a profound, even sudden emotional experience, to the point of being beside oneself"

MAIN POINT: Our response to the resurrection shapes our worship of the risen Christ.

POINT 1 The Women

Matt 28:1-10

24:6-8 (read, on screen). "Why do you seek the living among the dead? '6 He is not here but has risen. **Remember** how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, ⁷ that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise." 8 And they **remembered** his **words**."

So the journey of the women: **fear** → **remembering God** → **worship!**

POINT 2 The Guards

Matt 28:11-15

v11b: "they told ALL that had taken place."

So the journey of the guards: **fearing** \rightarrow **fleeing** \rightarrow **denial**.

Point 3 The Disciples

MT 28:17 some doubted

So the journey of the disciples: **unbelief** \rightarrow **examination** \rightarrow **belief**
