## SERMON HANDOUT Philippians 3:1-11 To Know Christ and Be Like Him

**Point 1:** Genuine Christians must guard against any confidence in our own works and trust in Christ alone for salvation. v1-3

- a.) Genuine faith is summed up by "Rejoice in the Lord." 1 Cor 1:30-31
- b.) Genuine faith is marked by "worship in the Spirit of God." John 4:24
- c.) Genuine faith is evidenced by "glorying in Christ Jesus." Jer 9:23-24
- d.) Genuine faith puts "no confidence in the flesh". Jer 17:5,7

Point 2: Genuine Christians count all personal accomplishments and merits as LOSS in order to GAIN Christ through faith. v4-9

Mt 5:48 contra we can't do anything perfectly → Romans 3:10-12

## **Point 3:** The goal of the Christian life is to know Christ and to be like Him. **v10-11**

- a. ) I want to know the power of His resurrection. Ephesians 3:16-19, Rom 8:11
- b.) I want to share in His sufferings.

Hebrews 5:8 "Jesus learned obedience through what He suffered." Mark 14:26 And he said, "Abba, Father, all things are possible for you.

Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

- 1 Pet 2:21-23......Christ suffered ....but continued entrusting himself to him who judges justly.
- c.) I want to be like Him in His death.

Paul said this in Gal 2:20 "I have been crucified with Christ....

- 3. According to 3:3, what are the three distinguishing marks of a genuine Christian?

- 5. Consider Pau's seven sources of false confidence (ritual, ethnicity, rank, tradition, rule keeping, zeal, and obedience to the law). Which source is most enticing for you? Why?
- 6. Why do you need Christ's perfect righteousness?
- 7. How can a defeated Christian learn experientially Christ's resurrection power over temptation and sin?
- 8. Believers have resurrection power. What is this power within you working to bring about?
- 9. How does suffering for Christ enable us to know Christ more? Why is a godly response to suffering so crucial for our growth?
- 10. How does the hope of your resurrection encourage you in the Christian life?
