Paul can maintain joy, in all circumstances, by staying focused on the gospel and the glory of Christ.

- 1. Focus on putting the Gospel First.
  - A). God's Plan is being Accomplished (v12)
  - B). People are hearing the Gospel (v13)
  - C). People are speaking the Gospel (v14)

- 2. Focus on God's Glory more than my own.
  - A). Check yourself before you wreck yourself (v15-17)
  - B). Rejoice when Christ is proclaimed (v18)
